





Notebook


- Have students demonstrate their grasp of content and skills throughout the lesson in their auto-saved **Notebooks**.

Flexible Assignments

- Use the "What" area to assign only the specific content your students need access to.

- Get as granular as you need in the "When" area. Control access down to the minute.
- Need a place to write specific instructions for the assignment? Add it in the "Optional" area before assigning.

Flexible Grading

- Who says grading has to be tedious? Choose view by student if you want to see how well a student understands the content, or choose view by question if you wish to speed through the grading process.
- Want to see students' responses even though their work is still in progress? Toggle to "answered" to filter out the unanswered questions.
- You can also add comments or stamps as you work your way down the questions and change the default score to meet your needs.
