

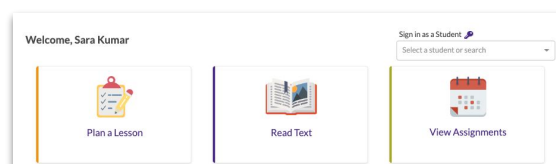
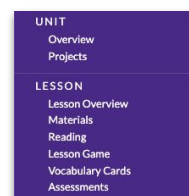


## Getting Started with Your TCI Social Studies Teacher Account

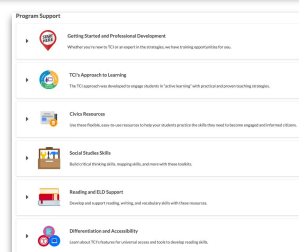
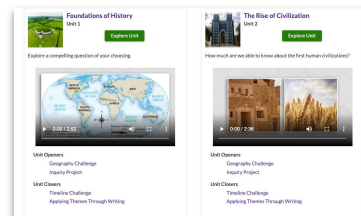
### Navigating TCI

- You and your students can quickly access TCI resources using the purple Sidebar.
- The resources and the arrangement of the purple Sidebar will vary across elementary, middle school, and high school social studies programs.
- Curious to know what your students see? Sign in as a student from the Program Dashboard.



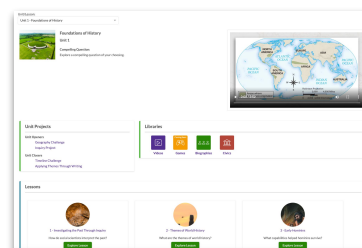
### Program Content

- The **Program Content** page highlights all the units within the program, giving you and your students a quick access to the unit projects, which include the Unit Openers and Unit Closers.

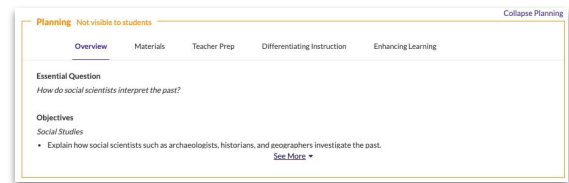
### Unit Overview

- The Unit Page shows you the **Lessons**, **Unit Projects**, and **Libraries** you need for big-picture planning.



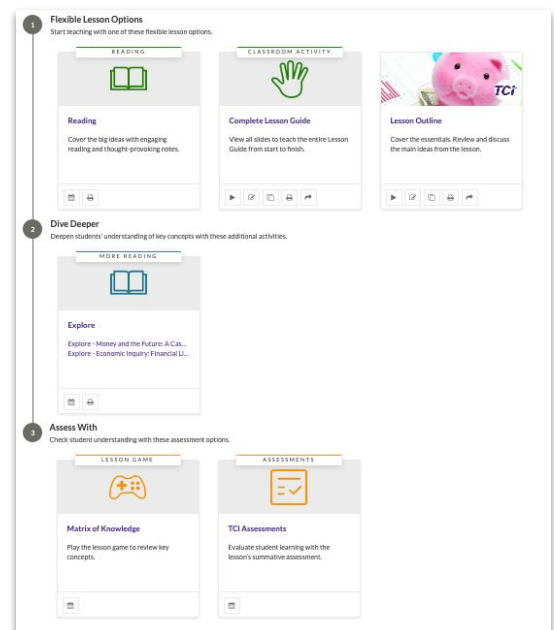
## Lesson Planning

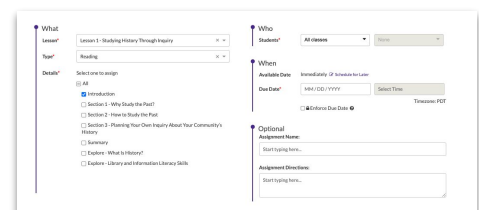
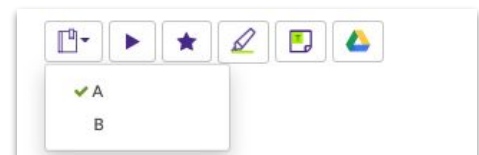
## Flexible Lesson Options

- The Lesson Page shows different ways to teach the content. Start by choosing one of the flexible lesson options.
- Want students to have access to questions or instructions only available in the Lesson Guide? Share it with a click of a button using the “**Share with students**” button.
- Want to dive deeper? Pick one of the enrichment resources available for the lesson.
- Finally, check for understanding by choosing from a variety of tools—from games to summative assessments.



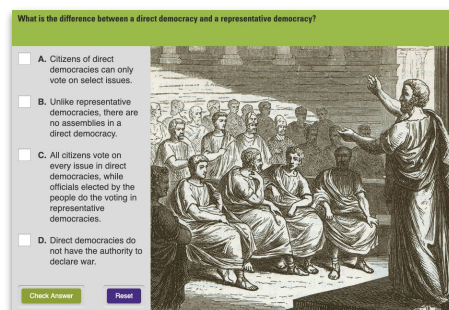
## Student Text Support

- Meet student needs with the **Reading Level** option:
  - Level A** text is within the grade-level Lexile range.
  - Level B** text is in a range two grades below grade level.
- Highlight** text, save **notes**, and reveal **Main Ideas**.
- Download the reading to **Google Drive** or **print** it out as needed.
- Assign** the text to students via your district LMS.



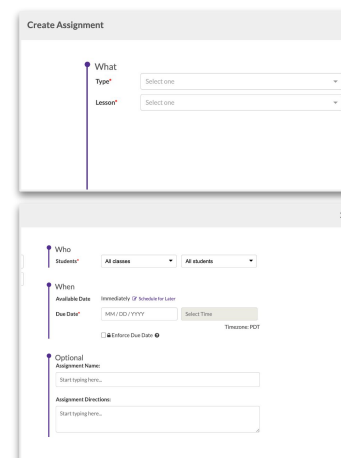
## Notebook

- Have students demonstrate their grasp of content and skills throughout the lesson in their auto-saved **Notebooks**.
- The Check for Understanding activities motivate students to engage with content in a variety of creative ways and self-assess by receiving immediate non-graded feedback.



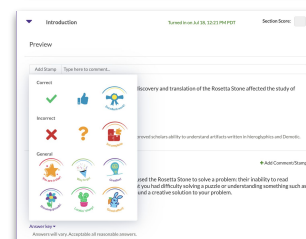
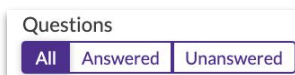
## Flexible Assignments

- Use the “What” area to assign only the **specific content** your students need access to.
- In the “Who” area, **assign to individual students** or entire classes.
- Get as granular as you need in the “When” area. Control **access down to the minute**.
- Need a place to write specific instructions for the assignment? Add it in the “Optional” area before assigning.



## Flexible Grading

- Who says grading has to be tedious? Choose **view by student** if you want to see how well a student understands the content, or choose **view by question** if you wish to speed through the grading process.
- Want to see students’ responses even though their work is still in progress? Toggle to **“answered”** to filter out the unanswered questions.
- You can also **add comments** or **stamps** as you work your way down the questions and change the default score to meet your needs.
- Stay on top of **Student Work** from the Program Dashboard.

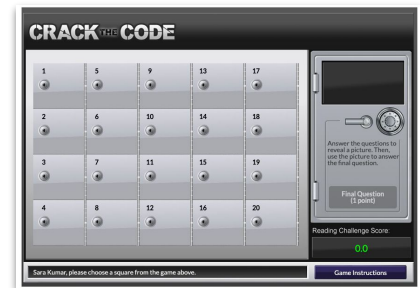


## Customizable Assessments

- Use TCI's default tests, tests created by teachers from your district, or get creative and craft your own!
- See a question that you really like in the Notebook? Add it in from our **Question Bank**. Want to test your students' knowledge in a way that's unique to your class? Make your own questions using any of our question types: multiple choice (can have more than one answer!), writing, table, drawing, fill-in-the-blank, or multiple image choice.

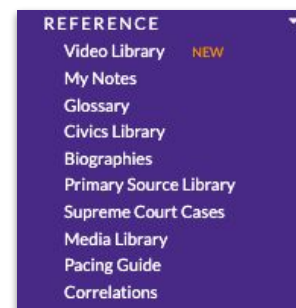
## Interactive Lesson Games

- Individual **Lesson Game** results and overall class trends are available to help you know which topics you might need to give more coverage.



## Reference

- The **Reference** area is also where students can access any notes they've made in the reading.



## Settings

- The **Settings** page gives you complete control over your account and what your student can access.
- Change your TCI account credentials anytime with the **My Account** tab.

- Control what students can access with the **Student Features** tab. Students see all of the Notebook sections and Lesson Games by default.
- Select your default points per Notebook or what results you want highlighted from the **Grades** tab.
- Select what students can see during and after a test and what content they can have access to from the **Student Access** tab.
- Explore and enable new features from the **Opt-In Features** tab.
- Connect and check the status of your LMS integration from the **Integrations** tab.
